With gratitude to God for the year that is ending, I present to you some activities carried out together with the Portuguese Methodist Church. In my missionary activities, I have had the opportunity to contribute to the Portuguese Methodist Church in various areas, such as in the coordination of the Instituto Bíblico Teológico Metodista; as a member of the Ministry of Mission and Evangelization; in the national commission for children and adolescents; as invited pastor to accompany the Department of Methodist Women.

Monthly I hold a meeting with the employees of the National Headquarters, carrying out a discipleship. This time has been a pleasant time; a time for sharing experiences and strengthening relationships and spiritual growth.

Portuguese Methodist Youth meet Ukrainian immigrants

Portuguese and Ukrainian refugee children and adolescents met in August 2022 in an initiative of the leaders of the Methodist and Presbyterian churches.

The Portuguese group had the opportunity to listen to the experiences of young Ukrainians who have been dealing with specific difficulties caused by war like living in another country,

learning to speak another language, living in a different culture, being far from home and family.

Portuguese Biblical Institute has classes given by Brazilian professors

As a former student and also a former professor at Methodist University of São Paulo, I managed to get an agreement between the IBTM, Instituto Bíblico Teológico Metodista, in Portugal, and the Faculty of Theology of the Methodist Church in Brazil.

Brazilian professors will teach remotely (via videocall) and also offers the possibility for Portuguese students to spend a few weeks studying in Brazil.

The IBTM currently has around 60 students who are preparing to serve God and the Church through pastorate or diakonia.
